



The Cholera Epidemic in Haiti today threatens all Haitians, especially the most vulnerable children and the elderly. Over 18,000 cholera cases have been reported as of today, with over 1,100 deaths so far in the crisis. Thousands of other deaths have likely not yet been counted due to the inability of those people in rural areas to be able to reach medical facilities in time.

Emergency Preventive Measures were implemented Monday, November 15, effective immediately, at all Mercy & Sharing program sites, in the following regions of Haiti:

Archaie, Williamson – Two Orphanages with 115 children, a physical therapy unit and a Community Clinic treating the surrounding area.

Port-au-Prince – John Branchizio Primary & Secondary school with 490 students.

Cite Soleil – Primary School with 175 students.

The region near Cap Haitian – Daily Nutrition Program serving 1,100 to 1,300 children and elderly every day.

***NOW IN PLACE** are strict regulations and about who can go in and out of our facilities, and the need to sanitize hands and feet upon entry and exit at all of our program sites. We therefore have a huge need for soap, bleach and clean water to be made available to as many people as possible in Haiti. Mercy & Sharing has implemented a Water Production Program and we continue to pump water 12 hours a day using a diesel generator to produce electrical power. Also, our ambulance in Port-au-Prince has been fully mobilized to help during the crisis.





Funds are Urgently Needed to purchase:

- 50,000 bars of soap,
- 100 barrels (115 lbs each) of Clorox bleach,
- Antibiotics,
- 50,000 Aquatab water purifying tablets,
- 30 gallons of diesel fuel to operate water pump 12 hours per day,
- Rehydration serum and body bags for distribution in rural areas.

COSTS FOR THE QUANTITIES listed above are:

Soap - \$11,000.

Aquatab water purification tablets - \$5,000.

Clorox - \$13,500.

Fuel to power our water pump: \$100 per day (30 gallons of fuel per day).
